CORRESPONDENCE

Curry County (Burn Piles across from PHS) – Aaron has been in contact with the county. Burn piles should be lit on the Monday of Thanksgiving break, minimizing impact on PHS students and staff. Replanting plans will be scheduled following this work, and our PHS students should have learning opportunities available through the restoration process.

BOARD

Aaron's Work – Although we asked for quite a bit more funding, we did receive a US Department of Justice COPS grant in the amount of \$154,313. We have accepted the agreement and will begin working on developing a final expenditure plan based on prioritization of the projects listed.

Aaron has also been busy completing grant reporting requirements for our High School Success, Student Investment Account and Early Literacy Grant awards from the Oregon Department of Education.

Parent/Community/Student Engagement Survey and Meeting – Aaron is working with Ms. Jones to conduct this survey for students later this month, and to hold a Community Engagement work session and survey for families on Tuesday, November 12 at 6pm.
