TITLE: Consider Authorizing the Sale and Disposal of

Commodities

BACKGROUND/CONSIDERATIONS:

Section 7.13 of the District policies allows the Superintendent to submit a list of surplus commodities to the Board for authorization to sell such surplus commodities. While a specific list will be accumulated and finalized by a future sale date, we can share that some of these commodities are located at the property formerly known as Trusty Elementary. Other commodities are currently located at the Wheeler Avenue location.

The authorization to sell these surplus commodities (known as Trusty items and Wheeler items) allows the District to auction all items to the general public before our July 2025 school board meeting date.

These portable buildings are at the Wheeler Avenue location and will be part of the Wheeler items:

Building #19	Fixed Asset #8339	Formerly at Spradling Elementary
Building #21	Fixed Asset #8258	Formerly at Sutton Elementary
Building #23	Fixed Asset #8317	Formerly at Trusty Elementary
Building #24	Fixed Asset #8219	Formerly at Trusty Elementary

Commodities not sold are considered to have no fair market value and will be disposed of by the District.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Administration recommends the Board consider authorizing the sale or disposal of the Trusty and Wheeler commodities.

If the Board agrees, the motion would read: move to authorize the sale or disposal of commodities known as the Trusty items and the Wheeler items.
