Background Information:

- Per the Texas Education Code, “The minutes of the last regular meeting of the Board of Trustees held before an election of trustees must reflect whether each trustee has met or is deficient in meeting the training required for the trustee as of the first anniversary of the date of the trustee’s election or appointment.” [Texas Education Code, Section 11.159(b)]
- If the minutes reflect that a trustee is deficient, the district shall post the minutes on the district’s website within 10 business days of the meeting and maintain the posting until the trustee meets the requirements.

Administrative Considerations:

- Reporting of continuing education requirements for School Board Members are reported annually at the last Board meeting prior to the Board Election.
