SUBJECT

Consideration of Approval of a Dual Credit Advantage Program

RECOMMENDATION

The District President recommends approval of a Dual Credit Advantage Program for graduating high school seniors who have completed a minimum of nine Collin College dual credit hours by the end of the spring semester to take up to seven credit hours free during the summer following their spring graduation. This tuition waiver will be limited to 800 students meeting the criteria. This program will be run as a pilot for Summer 2025, 2026, and 2027.


RATIONALE

The program will provide additional incentives for future students to participate in dual credit. The program will also aid the College in maximizing House Bill 8 funding while providing the College's P12 partners with an additional opportunity to maximize their state funding. The tuition incentive will align with Collin's strategic goals by supporting the creation and implementation of more comprehensive pathways to enrich the student experience and support student completion.
