FEBRUARY 2026


The Kaufman ISD maintenance team has continued to work on improvement projects around the district. In addition to those projects, there were over 170 work orders completed during the month of January.

Here are a few of the projects that the team has been working on this month:



The maintenance crew did a quick renovation to the softball concession stand. The team removed a bad counter top and replaced it with a newly built unit.





In January, the crew took some time to break down some old HVAC units so that the parts could be processed. They recovered the refrigerant and recycled the metals.




A severe ice storm hit the district last week. The crew used a variety of methods and machinery to help clear the roads, sidewalks and parking lots.



The ice was 3" thick in some places and extremely compacted.



The crew even had to use propane torches to break some of the ice loose. Wow!



And it wasn't just the ground that was covered in ice. Here, the crew works on breaking the ice from atop the roof at Helen Edwards. Excessive ice can contribute to roof leaks.
