### **CES Healthy Futures Challenge**

- The CES is participating in the Spring Healthy Futures Challenge through the State of Alaska once again this year. As you may recall, Healthy Futures is the signature program of the 501(c)3 nonprofit Alaska Sports Hall of Fame, Inc. Healthy Futures works to empower youth to build the habit of daily physical activity through core programs, such as the Healthy Futures Challenge and supporting community physical activity events.
- The CES Spring Healthy Futures Challenge will run for three months – February, March, and April of 2022. CES students will have the opportunity to record their physical activity on the Healthy Futures Activity Log. Qualifying logs must show at least 60-minutes of physical activity during a day, for at least 15-days of the month. When logs are completed, students/teachers will turn them in to receive a raffle ticket along with their monthly prize. Raffle tickets will then be placed in a raffle box for a grand prize drawing at the end of the year. One ticket per school will be drawn at the end of the year, and that student may choose from a menu of items including a disc golf set, spike ball, ladder ball, or a Healthy Futures hoodie.
