Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the 1st Cycle (August 16, 2017 – September 29, 2017).

Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from PEIMS (August 16– September 29).

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for the 1st cycle is 97.21%.
- The lowest total attendance averages are for 12th graders at 95.46% followed by 11th graders at 96.15%.
- The highest attendance averages are in the 2nd grade at 97.81% followed by 6th graders at 97.80%.
- Comparison:
 - 2016 1st grading cycle was 97.69%
 - 2015 1st grading cycle was 97.12%
 - 2014 1st grading cycle was 97.17%
 - 2013 1st grading cycle was 97.27%.
 - 2012 1st grading cycle was 97.44%.
