Comprehensive Achievement and Civic Readiness Plan



1) CE Jacobson Early Literacy SMART Goal:

Sixty percent of students attending 80% of scheduled school days will achieve a score of 26 picture names in one minute on the fluency screener.

2) Achievement Gap SMART Goal:

The percentage of all students receiving special education services enrolled October 1 in Rush City Schools who earn an achievement level of Meets the Standards or Exceeds the Standards in Reading on all 2025 state accountability tests will meet or exceed the pre-pandemic percentage of 27.9% in 2019.

3) Career and Post-Secondary SMART Goal:

All 8th grade students enrolled October 1 at Rush City High School will utilize the Minnesota Career Information System (MCIS) to develop a Personal Learning Plan (PLP) during the school year.

4) High School Graduation SMART Goal:

Of seniors enrolled on October 1st, 100% of them, who do not enroll in another district, will meet the requirements for graduation prior to the start of the 2026-2027 school year.

5) Prepare Students to be Lifelong Learners SMART Goal:

The percentage of students earning a regular high school diploma and who enrolled in any institution of higher education within 16 months of graduation will be greater than or equal to the 57% reported from the 2022 College-goers data as indicated in the Minnesota Report Card. This is a multi-year goal.
