1. Background:

Southwest High School, Southwest Legacy High School, and CAST STEM High School collectively service approximately 4,678 in grades 9-12. All middle schools in our district, including McAuliffe, McNair, Resnik, and Scobee, service approximately 3,120 students collectively in grades 6-8. While most of the instruction at these secondary campuses occurs in traditional settings, there exists an at-risk population within each campus that could benefit from the availability of an online curriculum and flexible scheduling. As a result, all secondary campuses are seeking approval to submit to the Texas Education Agency (TEA), the Optional Flexible School Day Program (OFSDP) application for the 2025-2026 school year. The OFSDP is a TEA-approved program that provides flexible attendance options for students.

## 2. <u>Process:</u>

This is a continuation of the Optional Flexible School Day Program (OFSDP). An application has been provided by the Texas Education Agency and has been completed by Southwest Independent School District.

3. <u>Fiscal Impact:</u> NA.

## 4. <u>Recommendation:</u>

That the board approve the 2025-2026 Optional Flexible School Day Program (OFSDP) for secondary schools.
