Climbing out of the pandemic

One year ago: \$5B deficit and 10%

unemployment

December: \$1B deficit and unemployment

cut in half

February: \$1.6B surplus

School Budgets Impacted

- May 2020 Education COVID bill
 - Fund transfer authority, forecast adjustments
- September 2020: Pandemic enrollment aid
- Compensatory hold harmless



Divided Legislature

- House DFL (71-58-4-1)
 - People of Color & Indigenous Caucus (POCI)
- Senate GOP (34-31-2)

Thin majorities and new sub-caucuses



Priorities

- Walz, House DFL & POCI Caucus:
 - Racial equity
 - Lots of funding and policy
- Senate no new taxes, no new policy



Getting to "Yes"

- May 17 Leadership agreement
 - E-12 = \$525M & \$675M
 - \$1.2B over 4 years
- Deadlines? May 28, June 4, 14 and 30....
- Trading offers

Senate GOP Offer

• 3%&1.5% = \$1.1B over 4 years

• Education Savings Accounts = Vouchers

Very little in new policy



House DFL Counteroffer

- 2%&2% = \$960M over 4 years
 - Salvage VPK slots
 - Money into EL and Special Ed
- Lots of new policy
