4.0 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Jesus Mendoza submitted a letter, which was read, to the Board in reference to how electo hypersensitivity (EHS) is caused and aggravated by exposure to the same wireless microwave radiation reaching children and teachers at school. EHS has been recognized by federal and state agencies and by courts as a physical medical condition and as a disability. A response to this evidence can save the lives of children and teachers. He thanked them for giving serious consideration to this matter.

He was pleased to announce that all eight singers competed and earned a Division 1– Superior rating on their solo performance. Out of the eight students, four of them also qualified to advance to the UIL State Solo & Ensemble Contest. He was very proud of the students for all of the hard work that they put into their solos. By next week, they will be submitting the virtual videos to the judges.

5B RECOGNITION OF SKILLS USA STUDENTS

Amber White recognized Megan Ramirez for placing first in district and state in Restaurant Service, and Brian Briones, Jr. for placing first in district and state in Customer Service in Skills USA. Both of them will be advancing to Nationals. Also, in National FCCLA Skilled Event Competition Megan Ramirez placed first in Commercial Baking and Elexie Villarreal placed second in Food Art.

Jose Moreno recognized Coach Roy Williams for being a great role model and for going above and beyond for the students of Robstown ISD. The administration wanted to make sure that he knew that he was appreciated and for being recognized as the Corpus Christi Caller-Times Coach of the Year.

6.0 INFORMATIONAL ITEM(S)

6A 2021 SUMMER LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE – JUNE 16-19, 2021, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS

Jose Moreno reminded the board members of the upcoming 2021 Summer Leadership Institute scheduled for June 16-19, 2021, in San Antonio, Texas. He announced that the school district was selected to attend the conference face-to-face.

6B RISD EDUCATION FOUNDATION WALKATHON

Rumaldo Juarez announced that the Education Foundation would be sponsoring a walkathon on May 28, 2021. Each of the campuses will be hosting its own walkathon on the same day. The walkathon would end at the RECHS Football Stadium starting at 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. The goal was to raise \$20,000.000 and donations could be done in several ways. He encouraged everyone to attend. In the future, they plan to hire a part-time Executive Director for the Education Foundation.

For the record, Trustee H. Lopez was present virtually for the Regular Board meeting at 6:01 p.m.

6C RISD SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Jose Moreno presented a copy of the school district's Summer School Program Academy starting on June 7, 2021, through June 29, 2021, to the Board. Summer school will run from Monday through Thursday. He also presented a calendar of events for the month of May.

6D RECHS GRAUDATION UPDATES AND CELEBRATIONS

Jose Moreno reported that they have around one hundred and forty students that should graduate and around forty that they are still making up some time. The high school administration is working very hard with the students that are still lacking the criteria to graduate. The prom was a success and it was held in the RECHS Library. They had a total of one hundred and fifty students show up for the prom.

6E ESSER II GRANT APPLICATION

Jose Moreno reported that the school district has received an ESSER III Allocation Grant. The grant was a federal grant and the funds would not

be supplanted at the state level. The grant application deadline is July 31. 2021. The funding is to help address the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on students. They will need to get board, community, and staff input, and the total allocation of the grant is for \$12,506.034. Vanessa Riggs informed the board members that the funds are being provided, supplemental to all other fundings sources to school systems, and will not be supplanted at the state level. The total allocation for the school district will be \$12,506,034; however, the initial amount is \$8,337,356 and the school district will reapply for the difference of \$4,168,678. The school district must expend a minimum of 20% of the grant funds on evidence-based interventions, such as summer learning, extended school year programs; and ensure interventions respond to student academics, social and emotional needs, and address the impact of the coronavirus on students' populations as defined in ESEA Tier I, Part A, students experience homelessness, and youth in foster care. She also reviewed the statutory requirements, program requirements, allowable activities and use of funds. potential uses of funds, and district actions that they have taken thus far. This was a great opportunity for the school district's students and staff.

6F SUPERINTENDENT UPDATES

Jose Moreno reported that, as of May 10, 2021, they have a total of 2458 students enrolled face-to-face, 120 students in remote learning with a medical waiver, for a total of 2578 students enrolled. The ADA is at 84.9%; however, they needed to meet 80%. At this time, they are on track on meeting the hold harmless that the state is providing. Also, he presented the Discipline Report, total number of withdrawals, and number of letters that were sent out. On May 17, 2021, Moak and Casey will be making the first round on the Strategic Planning, and on the 18th, they will be meeting with the leadership team and in the afternoon with the community. Also, questions will be asked of the school district's students. In the month of July, they will be selling or auctioning the extra furniture that the school district has in storage.

6G LIST OF BILLS

Vanessa Riggs reported that the list of bills for the month of April 2021 was \$1,083,030.89. She asked if anyone had any questions on the lists of bills.

6H FINANCIAL STATEMENT REPORT

Vanessa Riggs reported that the General Fund total revenues for the end of April were \$20,076,391 and total expenditures were at \$17,384,097. They had revenues over expenditures of \$2,515,340. The ending Fund Balance at the end of April is at \$11,399,102. The Food Service had total revenues of \$661,520 and total expenditures of \$1,012,449. At this time, they are a negative of \$131,864 in the Food Service Fund. Hopefully with the increased participation in May and August they can minimize the negative fund balance. TEA has announced that they will be providing some additional funds of around \$140,000 for food service but not until 2022. The Interest and Sinking Fund for the end of April in revenues was at \$4,048,217, and total expenditures were at \$3,870,355. They have revenues of over expenditures of \$186,902. If they do not receive funds from the IRS Subsidy for August 2020 and February 2020, the school district would have to pay it out of the General Fund.

8.0 BUSINESS AND SUPPORT

8A DISCUSSION OF FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (COMPASS GROUP USA, INC., DBA (CHARTWELLS)

Jose Moreno reported that Louie Keef, Regional Manager for Chartwells, was present to discuss and provide an update on the food service program. The school district has had different incidents and issues that needed to be addressed. Mr. Keef will be addressing on how to rectify the situation, see what is not doing well, what needed to be fixed, and a plan of action. Mr. Keef reported that they have served over eight thousand meals; however, last week the system broke down and food was served that was not reviewed and checked out before going out. The Food Service Director will be resigning at the end of the year. The position has been posted to work collaboratively with the school district staff, they will be reviewing the staff and positions, training will be given on meal pattern specifications, production standards, and meal appeal for school nutrition program. There was no excuse for what happened because he owned everything that happened. After discussion, Dr. Moreno informed the Board that the Texas Department of Agricultural has to approve a renewal contract or a new company first before the school district can approve a renewal or hire a company. At this time the school district has the option to self-opt and hire a director to manage it, or they may be allowed to have an emergency RFP. Vanessa Riggs informed the Board that they had the following options: Renew with Chartwells pending contract renewal from TDA or implement self-operations. The school district would need to find a new Food Service Director immediately.
