FISCAL NOTE:	Results of Operations for Fiscal Year 2024-2025

Background Information:

- The TEA requires that an annual financial audit of the district's financial statements be performed by an independent certified public accountant. It is further required that the annual audit be presented for acceptance by the Board of Trustees within 150 days of the fiscal year end. However, this year the TEA has extended this deadline due to delays at the federal level.

Administrative Considerations:

- The firm Weaver and Tidwell, L.L.P., an independent certified public accounting firm, conducted the district's annual audit.
- Weaver and Tidwell will present an unmodified audit opinion on the district's financial statements. This type of opinion is the highest opinion an auditor can render.
- Due to issues at the federal government level, the Single Audit report will be presented at a later date. The TEA's extension of the reporting date was partly due to the hope that the issues would be resolved by now. Additional explanation of these circumstances will be presented at the meeting.
- The Annual Comprehensive Financial Report will be submitted to the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for consideration for the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting and to the Association of School Business Officials (ASBO) for consideration for the Certificate of Excellence in Financial Reporting. The district has received the ASBO and GFOA awards for the past seventeen years.
- A summary of the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report will be presented at the meeting.
