Dear Mr. Bauer,

We would like to take this opportunity to thank the Board of Education and Administration for allowing our firm the opportunity to provide services for Pana CUSD #8. Bushue HR, Inc. is an Outsourced Risk Management Company focusing on Human Resources, Risk Management, Insurance, and Background Screening & Fingerprinting services for School Districts throughout the State of Illinois.

The attached summary illustrates coverages for all Insurance Carriers/Agents presenting proposals. The first column of each page is the expiring insurance coverage for the District. The second column is the renewal coverage as presented by the current Insurance Carrier and Agent. The subsequent columns denote the agency name submitting the bid at the top, as well as the Insurance Carrier. In total, we had eight (8) Agents contact us regarding an interest in bidding on the District. We received proposals back from five (5) of those Agents. Those Insurance Agents are listed below.

Notes about the proposals:

- The Blanket Limit and Statement of Values (SOV) for the Property have been reviewed with Administration, and the values have been increased to better reflect Replacement Cost Values. The Blanket Limit has been increased from \$63,281,624 to \$65,180,073.
- Under the Inland Marine, the value for the Electronic Data Processing (EDP) Equipment has been increased from \$350,000 to \$375,000; per the District's request.
- The Worker's Compensation payrolls have been increased for the renewal, per the District's request. The 8868 Class Code (Colleges or Schools, Teachers) payroll has been increased from \$5,771,038 to \$5,944,169; the 7380 Class Code (Drivers, Chauffeurs, & Their Helpers) payroll has been increased from \$404,555 to \$416,692; and the 9101 Class Code (All Other Employees) payroll has been increased from \$872,741 to \$898,923.
- The Worker's Compensation rates have been modified for the renewal.
- The Experience Modification Rating has been increased from a 0.88 in 2018 to a 0.93 for 2019. The standard Experience Modification Rating is 1.00.



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• Alternative Options were quoted and analyzed with Administration, as a part of the bidding process.

We evaluated all Package proposals along with evaluating all individual proposals to see what options would be the most advantageous for the Board of Education to consider. After reviewing and evaluating all options, the Package renewal through Wright Specialty Insurance (WSI) with the Worker's Compensation through State National would be the lowest proposal. This proposal matches the current coverages that are in place. This proposal reflects a savings of \$55,289; which is 27.09% less than the expiring.

The second lowest proposal is through Liberty Mutual for the Package and State National for the Worker's Compensation. This proposal reflects differences from the expiring, such as; decreased Data Compromise Limits, decreased Backup of Sewers/Surface Water coverage, increased Time Element (Extra Expense Limit), increased General Liability Limits, and increased coverage for Replacement Cost on Buses. This proposal reflects a savings of \$54,906; which is 26.90% less than the expiring.

The third lowest proposal is through the Prairie State Insurance Cooperative (PSIC). The PSIC program has set Limits and Deductibles Per Occurrence within their program. Therefore, there are differences between the renewal from WSI and PSIC. Please see the comparison below.

Comparison of Coverages between WSI, State National, and PSIC:

- The District carries a \$2,500 Property Deductible Per Occurrence through WSI. PSIC has a set Property Deductible Per Occurrence of \$1,000.
- The District carries a \$10,000,000 Earthquake Coverage Limit with a 10% Deductible Per Occurrence through WSI. PSIC provides a Pooled Limit of \$76,000,000 in Earthquake Coverage with a \$1,000 Deductible Per Occurrence.
- The District carries a \$100,000 Data Compromise Limit with a \$1,000 Deductible Per Occurrence through WSI. PSIC provides a \$1,000,000 Limit with a \$2,500 Deductible Per Occurrence.
- The District carries a \$10,000,000 Flood Coverage Limit with a \$25,000 Deductible Per Occurrence through WSI. PSIC provides a Pooled Limit of \$61,000,000 in Flood Coverage with a \$1,000 Deductible Per Occurrence.
- The District carries a \$500,000 Time Element (Extra Expense) Limit through. PSIC provides a Limit of \$1,000,000.
- The District carries General Liability Aggregate Limits of \$2,000,000 with Occurrence Limits of \$1,000,000. PSIC provides the Aggregate Limits at \$4,000,000 with the Occurrence Limits at \$2,000,000.
- The District carries a \$100,000 Fire Damage Limit under the General Liability Coverage; whereas, PSIC provides the coverage at a Limit of \$500,000.
- The District carries a \$300,000 Adverse Event Response Limit. PSIC provides a Limit of \$3,000,000.
- The District carries the Employee Dishonesty Limit and Computer Fraud Limit at \$100,000 with a \$500 Deductible Per Occurrence. PSIC provides the coverage Limits at \$1,000,000 with a \$1,000 Deductible Per Occurrence.

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- WSI quoted the Full Blanket Limit for the Boiler and Machinery Coverage, whereas PSIC quoted the program Limit of \$250,000,000.
- The District carries a \$500 Auto Comprehensive and Collision Deductible Per Occurrence; whereas PSIC offers their minimum Deductibles Per Occurrence of \$1,000 for Auto Comprehensive and Collision.
- The District carriers an Umbrella Aggregate Limit of \$10,000,000; whereas PSIC provides the Umbrella Aggregate Limit at \$18,000,000.
- The District carries the Worker's Compensation Employers Liability Limits at \$1,000,000; whereas PSIC provides the Limits at \$2,000,000.
- The District carries the School Board Legal Liability (SBLL) Aggregate Limit at \$2,000,000 and the Occurrence Limit at \$1,000,000. PSIC provides the SBLL Aggregate Limit at \$4,000,000 and the Occurrence Limit at \$2,000,000.
- The District carries the SBLL and the Employment Practices Liability Insurance (EPLI) Deductibles Per Occurrence at \$2,500. PSIC is unable to offer the Deductibles Per Occurrence at \$2,500; therefore, the proposal reflects their minimum SBLL and EPLI Deductibles Per Occurrence of \$10,000.
- The District carries the Non-Monetary Defense Expense Limit at \$100,000 with a \$2,500 Deductible Per Occurrence; whereas, PSIC provides the Limit at \$500,000 with a \$10,000 Deductible Per Occurrence.
- The District carries the SBLL coverage with no Retroactive Date; whereas, PSIC is unable to
 offer the coverage with Full Prior Acts. Therefore, PSIC provides their set Retroactive Date of
 July 1, 2006.
- WSI has been in the school insurance market many years, they appear to be financially stable and have a good history of servicing claims.
- PSIC has a common effective date of July 1st. If accepted, the policy would be written on a term of February 16, 2019 through July 1, 2019; for a pro-rated premium of \$33,006 for the Package coverages and \$27,777 for the Worker's Compensation coverage. PSIC will re-rate the District's coverages for the July 1, 2019 through July 1, 2020 policy term.
- Under the PSIC Program, the District has a three (3)-year commitment to the program, with no rate/premium guarantee after the first year.
- PSIC includes Pollution Liability, Blanket Student Accident, and Catastrophic Student Accident within the program.
- PSIC carriers are all "A" rated or better.
