

Research Findings:

- 1. Proficient reading by end of 3rd grade
- 2. Family income matters (Hart & Risley, 1995), (NCES, NAEP 2013)
- 3. Family Education matters (Mabry, 1997)
- 4. Reading proficiency prevents dropouts(Hernandez, 2011)),
- 5. Number of words heard before age of 4 (Herri.2011)
- 6. Teacher Quality (Darling-Hammond, 2010)
- 7. Time spent reading and writing (Wei, et.al, 2010)
- 8. Balance between phonics and integrated ELA activities (Wei, Darling-Hammond & Adamson, 2010)
- 9. Oral Language is important (Hart and Risley, 1995)
- 10. Reading impacts earning potential (Heckman, 2011),






