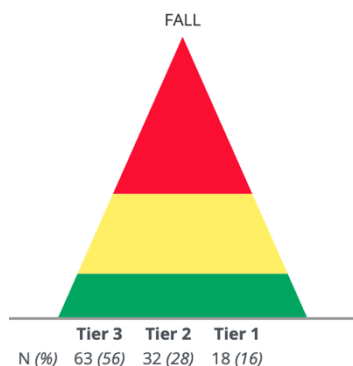
September 2025

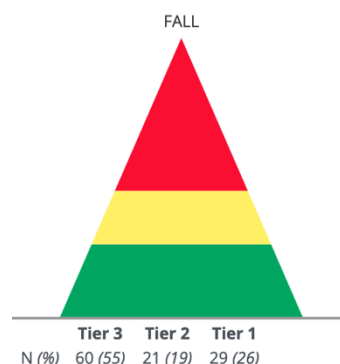
Early Numeracy testing is also nearing completion with 110 of 113 kindergarten students assessed and 120 of 125 first graders.

Aimswest Early Numeracy-K

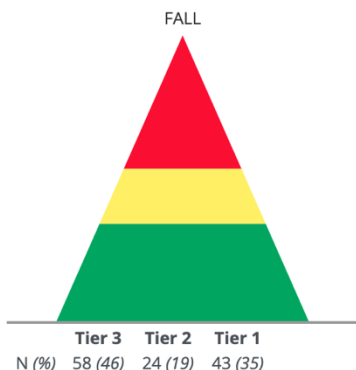


The Spring goals for Kindergarten:

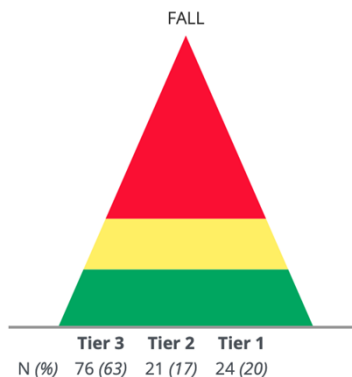

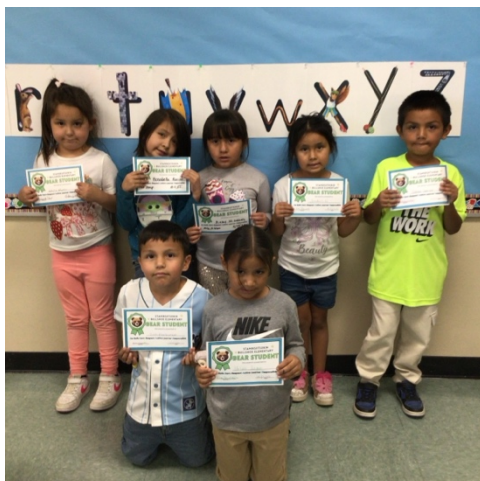
