Gloria S. Rendon: Yes, board members, we presented this item at the Instructional Committee last week. Basically what it is; is a program that would be in it's 3rd year at LBJ High School and it is a program designed to work with the individuals that are at Risk of dropping out of School or not meeting the graduation requirements. The Texas Education Agency offers school districts the opportunity to offer this type of program for a student who may be at Risk of either dropping out of school or who would be denied credit for one or more classes in which the student has been enrolled as a result of attendance requirements. This past year we had 24 students involved in the program, 5 of our students graduated from this program, more importantly besides the graduates we had 159 credits that were recovered among those particular students who were participants. So, it is an effective program, we do designate 1 teacher at this particular campus to work with the students. They have a flexible schedule; they go from 8 AM-12 PM or from 12:30-4:30 PM.

Some of these students we have learned that they have to help with their households, work or have other needs that prevent them from going to school for the entire day. TEA also offers the opportunity to capture full day ADA for these particular students who are enrolled in this particular program. So we ask for your approval of extending this program for it's 3^{rd} year.
