AR 6146.1-1 HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Craig High School Early Graduation

General high school graduation requirements for Craig High School (CHS) are outlined in CCSD Board Policy 6146 and include successful completion of 25-units of credit.

The typical credit accumulation progression requires eight (8) semesters of coursework. CCSD recognizes that some CHS students may earn credits beyond those offered by CHS and may satisfy graduation requirements early. CCSD offers CHS students in this position the opportunity to apply for Early Graduation. To be a candidate for CHS Early Graduation, a student must have earned nineteen (19) credits by the end of their third year of high school. CHS students must still obtain the 25-credits necessary for graduation.

CHS Early Graduation requests must be verified by the CHS Principal and formally submitted in writing to the CCSD Superintendent for CCSD School Board approval. Additionally, requests for CHS Early Graduation shall be submitted to the CCSD School Board by the end of the first quarter grading period in the school year from which the student intends to graduate early, unless extenuating or exceptional circumstances exist.

High school graduation ceremonies shall be held to recognize those students who have successfully completed the district graduation requirements and earned the right to receive a diploma or a certificate of completion (see CCSD Board Policy 5127). CHS students receiving CCSD School Board approval for CHS Early Graduation may participate in their Class's regularly scheduled graduation ceremony.
