At the district level, results are not reported when there are fewer than 30 respondents.


For schools, results are not reported when there are fewer than 30 respondents or the response rate is below 30%.



- 11% increase for American Indian/Alaskan Native students.
- Ongoing partnership with law enforcement agencies.

#### Issues:

10% decrease for Pacific Islander students.


### This year:


- Implementation of BSD Student Threat Assessment Process that includes training for all school counselors, psychologists, and building administrators.
- Implementation of the 5D framework for instruction.
- Training of all district administrators in Culturally Responsive Teaching Practices.
- Restorative Justice training for some administrators.
- Training for all secondary administrators and some staff in AVID strategies.
- Implementation of the Active Students Task Force Pilot.
- Access for every student to rigorous physical activity every week.
- Support for schools around Positive Behavior Intervention Strategies.

### Long-term:

- Further development of school and district PBIS program.
- Training of all staff in Culturally Responsive Teaching Practices.
- Training of all staff in Restorative Justice practices.
- Building capacity for accountability for full PBIS implementation.

- 8% decrease in all staff reporting.

#### **Action Plan**


#### This year:


- Executive administrators are providing side-by-side coaching for principals in developing safe, inclusive, and respectful school cultures.
- Training of all district administrators in Culturally Responsive Teaching Practices.
- Leading for Equity professional development for all new administrators.
- Targeted support for school staffs through the Department of Equity and Inclusion.
- Professional development sessions offered on hiring culturally diverse staff.
- Human Resource department focus on developing a workforce that represents the BSD student population.

### Long-term:

 Continue providing supports and services for all staff around AVID and Culturally Responsive Practices.

## **Students Reporting Not Being Bullied**

#### **Analysis**

#### Successes:

 A number of elementary schools had double-digit gains in percentage of students reporting not being bullied.

#### Issues:

- Second year in a row with a 1% decrease.
- 16% decrease for Pacific Islander students.

#### **Action Plan**

### This year:

- Staffing increase resulting in minimum of one full-time counselor in every elementary, middle, and comprehensive school.
- Addition of five school Social Workers.
- Increase in staff in the Department of Equity and Inclusion.
- Support for schools around PBIS strategies.
- Leading for Equity professional development for new administrators.
- Restorative Justice training for some administrators.
- Hired counseling TOSA that is providing direct support to counselors around anti-bullying programs.
- Training for all counselors and some staffs in intervention strategies around suicide prevention.

## Long-term:

- Full implementation of PBIS strategies district-wide.
- Full implementation of anti-bullying curriculum district-wide.
- Training for all staff around suicide prevention.
