FNG (Local)	Student Rights and Responsibilities: Student & Parent Complains/Grievances	Requires complaint process and paperwork to be posted on District's website; significantly modifies the FNG timelines, clarifies designation of hearing officer for grievances, and allows the Board to designate a Board Committee to hear Level III appeals.
FO (Local)	Student Discipline	Prohibits use of corporal punishment; Authorizes Video and Audio recording for safety purposes; appoints campus principal as custodian of video records.
