History: Launched in 2005 at the 5 “Title 1 provision 1” schools in Jo. Co.

"Kids Smile" was developed in lieu of "Give Kids A Smile Day"

Currently we will invite all 15 schools in Jo. Co. to participate

Sponsored: as **partnership** of Siskiyou Community Health Center and Rogue Valley Dental Society.

Goal: to **increase access** to preventive dental care for the children of Josephine County.

Outreach: to all public school children in grades 2 and 3 (1st grade/sometimes all grades @ small schools)
