This letter is to inform you that San Antonio Preparatory, Inc. intends to submit an application to the Texas Education Agency in response to the Generation Twenty-Four Open-Enrollment charter school application process. Statutory guidelines require that applicants send the enclosed Statement of Impact form and a copy of the completed Application Coversheet to each district that may be affected by the proposed charter school. Your district is receiving this information because the proposed charter school's designated geographic boundary overlaps with your district's boundary. The proposed charter school's designated geographic boundary will include the following districts: Judson ISD, Alamo Heights ISD, Randolph ISD, Northeast ISD, Lackland ISD, San Antonio ISD, Fort Sam ISD, Schertz-Cibolo-Universal City ISD, Southside ISD, Harlandale ISD, South San Antonio ISD, Edgewood ISD, Southwest ISD, Northside ISD, Medina Valley ISD, and East Central ISD.

In addition, the proposed charter school will have a transfer policy whereby it may admit students residing outside of the designated geographic boundary once all eligible applicants residing within the geographic boundary have submitted a timely application and been enrolled. The transfer boundary will include the following districts: Judson ISD, Alamo Heights ISD, Randolph ISD, Northeast ISD, Lackland ISD, San Antonio ISD, Fort Sam ISD, Schertz-Cibolo-Universal City ISD, Southside ISD, Harlandale ISD, South San Antonio ISD, Edgewood ISD, Southwest ISD, Northside ISD, Medina Valley ISD, and East Central ISD.

The attached Statement of Impact form provides a district with an opportunity to inform the commissioner of whether the proposed charter school may adversely impact it financially or in some other respect. Completed forms may be returned to:
