Facility Advisory of Citizens, Teachers, and Students (FACTS) Committee

#### **Background Information**

The Board of Trustees established the Facility Advisory of Citizens, Teachers, and Students (FACTS) Committee to study the districts current facilities and needs for the future. The group, consisting of 50 people, held their 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting on March 26<sup>th</sup>. The Committee heard from Bill Smith with the City of Weatherford regarding economic and residential growth, looked at student enrollment trends, and heard results from a facility assessment completed by PBK Architects. The FACTS Committee will meet on April 30<sup>th</sup> at 6 p.m. at Ninth Grade Center for a tour and presentation from the school district's Financial Advisor, Jeff Roberts. The committee will meet each month through July with the intent of making a recommendation to the Board of Trustees a long-range facility plan and potential scenarios for a November 2025 bond election to meet the needs of the District.
