At the end of the 2025-2026 school year, Acadience Reading will be used to determine what percentage of the students in each grade that were able to make typical growth or more. These results are completed annually on each student and set by the State within the program.

- Intervention aides will be hired to work with small groups of students who are struggling to meet the proficiency goals set for each grade. (\$17,500)
- We will dedicate time for collaboration of teachers and intervention teams to ensure specific and prescriptive interventions are being appropriately provided for struggling learners. (\$1,000)
- We will have professional development for teachers and interventionists to improve student interventions. (\$2,000)
- Binders, paper, file folders, and laminating sheets for individual student data keepers will be purchased to help students (and teachers) track and measure student progress. (\$500)
