2021-2022 Casual Dress Code



ALLOWED

TOPS/SHIRTS

- Students may wear any top/shirt.
- Shirt/Top must fit the student properly.
- Any color and any print is allowed.

BOTTOMS

- Students may wear bottoms that fit the student properly.
- Jeans are allowed as well as leggings or jeggings and skirts/shorts/skorts.
- Students in grades 9-12 may wear shorts or skirts/skorts that are no shorter than 5 inches from the knee.

DRESSES

• Dresses must have sleeves and must fit appropriately (no shorter than 5 inches from the knee).

SHOES, OUTERWEAR & ACCESSORIES

- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Any color of shoes are allowed.
- Students may wear any color of outerwear.
- Outerwear must fit appropriately.
- Hoods attached to outerwear are not to be worn inside the buildings.

NOT ALLOWED

TOPS/SHIRTS

- Sleeveless, tank tops/cami top, tube or halter/crop or backless, sheer or see through tops.
- Lewd or inappropriate text/graphics.

BOTTOMS

- Pajama pants, sagging pants that are unnaturally fitting at the waist and crotch area. Torn or ripped pants, jeans, shorts/clothing.
- Mini skirts, mini- shorts, bike shorts, cutoffs, boxer shorts (shorts must be hemmed or cuffed with no torn or frayed edges).

DRESSES

• Mini dresses, halter dresses, sleeveless dresses, or backless dresses.

SHOES, OUTERWEAR & ACCESSORIES

- House shoes, pajama slippers, stiletto shoes, flip flops, athletic slides, shoes with wheels, hard plastic toe shoes or boots.
- Hats, caps, boots, bandanas.
- Sunglasses cannot be worn or carried in school buildings.
- Lewd or inappropriate text graphics.

Other Requirements & Restrictions

- · Students shall wear appropriate undergarments beneath their clothing (covering private areas of the body).
- Items with provocative, offensive, violent, or drug-related/gang-related pictures or slogans as determined by the campus principal will not be permitted. Items advertising pornography, drugs, alcoholic beverages, or tobacco products are strictly prohibited.

*FACE MASKS - masks covering nose and mouth are highly recommended.
