WHEREAS, to encourage the participation of girls in this state to consider career fields in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics; and

WHEREAS, to celebrate and honor the women of this state who have excelled in those fields; and

WHEREAS, each district may include appropriate instruction, activities, and programs to encourage and celebrate women in career fields related to science, technology, engineering, and mathematics throughout the month. The instruction may include programs that profile women in those fields and related fields, including finance, information technology, data analytics, cybersecurity, and health-care cloud architecture; and

WHEREAS, this date shall be regularly observed by appropriate ceremonies, activities, and programs in public schools, public institutions of higher education, and other places; and

WHEREAS, the Lamar CISD Board of Trustees would like to give many young girls the opportunity to learn, ask questions, and dive deeper into subjects they may not have been encouraged to explore otherwise by giving names, faces, and credit to the Texas women who are currently succeeding in their STEM careers;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Lamar Consolidated Independent School District declares March 1, 2026, as **Texas Girls in STEM Day** and encourages all members of our staff and community to celebrate this event.
