PUBLIC HEARING & REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING
MAY 18, 2026
MINUTES**

A Public Hearing and regular meeting of the School Board, Independent School District #162 was held on May 18, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. in BHS Room 101. Members present: Michael Mathison, Wendy Fultz, Amanda Koop, Andrew Bennett, John Gerbracht, Darin Klostermeier, and Superintendent Dr. Heise. Members absent: Dany Ekre.

1. Chairperson Mathison called the meeting to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
