## Background:

The District, specifically the Department of Instruction and Curriculum has received earbuds from Subway (Barrow) for student ownership to help assist with electronic delivery of educational content. The earbuds are compatible with the NSBSD issued student technology and can be used to help access online programs, like audio books and other instructional materials.

The estimated monetary value of the donation is approximately \$4,200.00.
