 - 2021-2022: 82%
 - 2022-2023: 80%
 - 2023-2024: 80%

STUDENT ROUNDTABLE TAKEAWAYS

Elementary:

- **Focus Area:** lack of school pride and increased education and consequences related to bullying
- **Celebration:** improved intervention and increased staff visibility

Junior High:

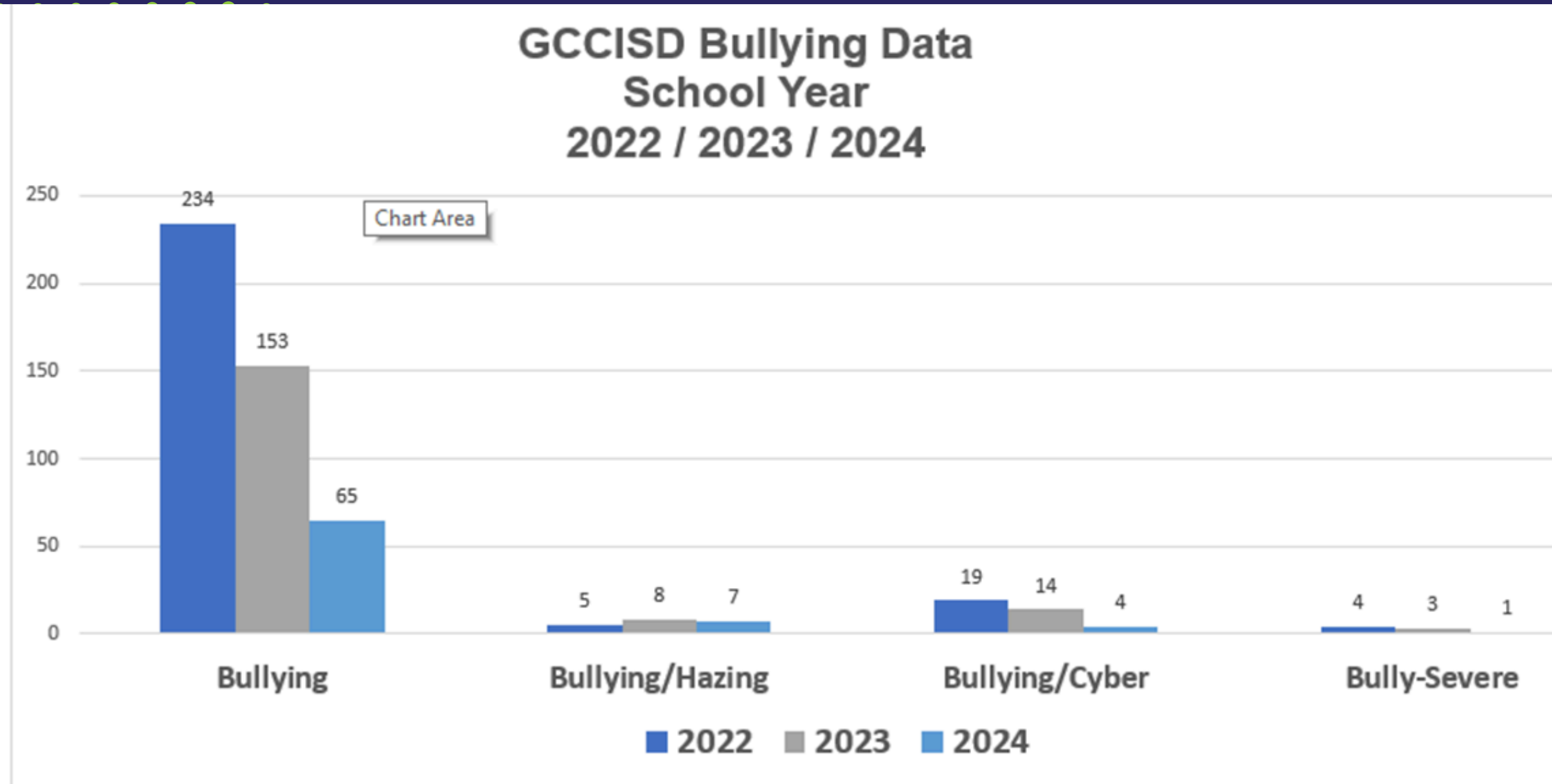
- **Focus Area:** students prefer anonymous reporting of bullying but fail to provide sufficient details for action
- **Celebration:** successful antibullying strategies have worked including mentorship programs, student ambassadors, and reporting tools

High School:

- **Focus Area:** students being more involved in reporting and preventing bullying
- **Celebration:** strong sense of belonging and relationships
