



 - 2024-2025:83%



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
STUDENT ROUNDTABLE TAKEAWAYS

Elementary:

- Focus Area: lack of school pride and increased education and consequences related to bullying
- Celebration: improved intervention and increased staff visibility **Junior High:**
 - Focus Area: students prefer anonymous reporting of bullying but fail to provide sufficient details for action
- Celebration: successful antibullying strategies have worked including mentorship programs, student ambassadors, and reporting tools **High School:**
 - Focus Area: students being more involved in reporting and preventing bullying
 - Celebration: strong sense of belonging and relationships
