Re: Panorama Survey Follow up Summary

Date: September 19, 2016

This follow-up summary compares the 2014/16 survey responses of all respondents to non-neutral respondents with the goal of further identifying/validating areas for continuous improvement.

A.Key Points:

1. Panorama surveys from 2014 and 2016 were consistent in questions asked as well as response choices for parents (Strongly Agree, Agree, Disagree, Strongly Disagree and Neutral).
2. Panorama survey data assists the school in setting and measuring goals.
3. The distribution of 2016 favorable responses (Combined Agree and Strongly Agree) is different but comparable when using all respondents (Category A) in calculations versus using only non-neutral respondents (Category B).

4. The three questions with the greatest growth in favorable responses from 2014 to 2016 were the same in both A and B: healthy food, clean/well maintained facilities, report card communication.

D. Recommendations for 2016-17

- a. Maintain school wide continuous improvement efforts in areas addressed in previous goals.
- b. Set 2016-17 school-wide educator goal: My child’s report card clearly communicates what my child is learning.
- c. Provide clarity of information for parents on areas/questions with high neutrality (more than 20%): Two areas – report cards and school board.
- d. Explore options for Panorama to group questions (administration, instruction, communication, etc.) for final survey report.
- e. Explore options on future survey administrations for responses that do not include Neutral or N/A.
