**Improve Completion Rates of the** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

In order to improve the completion rates of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid ("FAFSA") by students enrolled in the Madison Public Schools (the "District"), the

District will:

Develop a FAFSA Task Force to identify challenges, successes, and next steps in

improving the completion rates of the FAFSA among students in grade twelve.

Track data from such students regarding FAFSA completion, including date of

completion.

Identify FAFSA coaches who will be assigned a caseload of students to assist

students in completing the FAFSA and monitor their completion rates.

Provide incentives to students who have completed the FAFSA, which may include

but are not limited to, spirit days and giveaways, if funding permits.

Conduct annual presentations to students about the purpose and importance of the

FAFSA and the District's resources available to help students in completing the

FAFSA.

Provide professional development to identified District staff regarding the FAFSA

and best practices for supporting students in completing the FAFSA.
