SUBJECT: Consideration and possible approval for 10 middle schools

to travel to The Hobby Center to watch fine arts performances starting September 24, 2025, through

January 21, 2026.

BACKGROUND: The Hobby Center and ExxonMobil have partnered with

local districts to provide fifth grade students the opportunity to experience live theatre, dance, and music by Houston-based artists, at no cost to us. Ten middle schools will attend the shows starting September 24 are performed through January 21. Shows professionals respective fields: in their actors. choreographers. comedians. dancers. composers. arrangers, musicians conductors. singers, and Approximately 3,000 students and 300 chaperones from 10 different middle schools will attend these shows. These numbers will comply with district requirements of a 10 to 1 ratio of students to adult chaperones. All chaperones will school district policy trained in responsibilities and duties prior to the trip. All rules of conduct established by the school district will be strictly

enforced.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: Performance tickets are valued at \$25 per person of direct

expenses. The total value of our tickets is approximately \$70,075. This expense, along with transportation to the events, will be covered by The Hobby Center and

ExxonMobil at no additional cost to Pasadena ISD.

RECOMMENDATION: We recommend approval for 10 of our middle schools to

travel to the Hobby Center and watch these performances

from September 24, through January 21.
