
- Referrals went down by 5

- We find most of our referrals that make it to the administrative level are higher level and mostly serious in nature.
- 24 students received referrals 4 students received 2 referrals and 15 received only 1.
- That calculates to 5 students accounting for half of the referrals.



Behavior by Student Group




Analysis:

Student Behavior by Student Group




