**A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE
NORTH SLOPE BOROUGH REGULAR ELECTION
HELD ON OCTOBER 1, 2024, FOR SIX ASSEMBLY
MEMBER SEATS, THREE SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER
SEATS AND EIGHT PROPOSITIONS**

WHEREAS, the Regular Election of the North Slope Borough was held on October 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the North Slope Borough Assembly met as the Borough Canvass Board on October 8, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the candidate who receives the highest number of votes in excess of forty (40) percent of the votes cast for his or her respective office shall be declared elected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Regular Election held on October 1, 2024, regarding the election of the six Assembly member seats, three School Board member seats and eight propositions was a validly held election.
2. That in accordance with Resolution 71-2024, regarding counting of absentee and question ballots, the Borough Election Official, Sheila Burke, counted the absentee and question ballots of the North Slope Borough Regular Election of October 1, 2024.

A.	<p>Proposition 1, Shall the North Slope Borough, Alaska, issue its general obligation bonds, in an amount not to exceed the sum of Twenty-Seven Million Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$27,270,000) for the purpose of financing the cost, in whole or in part, of the construction, additions, improvements, betterments, repair, reconstruction or acquisition of schools and buildings related to education and facilities related thereto in the North Slope Borough as set forth in the Capital Budget Ordinance, together with all necessary appurtenances, equipment, furnishings and facilities, and the acquisition of lands or rights in lands in connection therewith, including underwriting discount and other costs of issuance of such bonds, in accordance with and ratifying and approving the provisions of Ordinance 2024-12 of the North Slope Borough adopted by the Borough Assembly on August 6, 2024, including the provisions thereof pertaining to reappropriations of the proceeds of any bonds to other Capital Projects and other Capital Project Funds under certain circumstances.</p> <p>YES-583 NO -74</p>
B.	<p>Proposition 2, Shall the North Slope Borough, Alaska, issue its general obligation bonds, in an amount not to exceed the sum of Fifteen Million One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$15,150,000) for the purpose of financing the cost, in whole or in part, of the construction, additions, improvements, betterments, repair, reconstruction or acquisition of public roads, streets, water-course and flood-control facilities and facilities related thereto in the North Slope Borough as set forth in the Capital Budget Ordinance, together with all necessary appurtenances, equipment, furnishings and facilities, and the acquisition of lands or rights in lands in connection therewith, including underwriting discount and other costs of issuance of such bonds, in accordance with and ratifying and approving the provisions of Ordinance 2024-13 of the North Slope Borough adopted by the Borough Assembly on August 6, 2024, including the provisions thereof pertaining to reappropriations of the proceeds of any bonds to other Capital Projects and other Capital Project Funds under certain circumstances.</p> <p>YES - 586 NO -73</p>
C.	<p>Proposition 3, Shall the North Slope Borough, Alaska, issue its general obligation bonds, in an amount not to exceed the sum of Twenty-Four Million Three Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$24,315,000) for the purpose of financing the cost, in whole or in part, of the construction, additions, improvements, betterments, repair, reconstruction or acquisition of water facilities and facilities related thereto in the North Slope Borough as set forth in the Capital Budget Ordinance, together with all necessary appurtenances, equipment, furnishings and facilities, and the acquisition of lands or rights in lands in connection therewith, including underwriting discount and other costs of issuance of such bonds, in accordance with and ratifying and approving the provisions of Ordinance 2024-14 of the North Slope Borough adopted by the Borough Assembly on August 6, 2024, including the provisions thereof pertaining to reappropriations of the proceeds of any bonds to other Capital Projects and other Capital Project Funds under certain circumstances.</p>

F.	<p>Proposition 6, Shall the North Slope Borough, Alaska, issue its general obligation bonds, in an amount not to exceed the sum of Thirty-One Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$31,350,000) for the purpose of financing the cost, in whole or in part, of the construction, additions, improvements, betterments, repair, reconstruction or acquisition of public safety facilities and facilities related thereto in the North Slope Borough as set forth in the Capital Budget Ordinance, together with all necessary appurtenances, equipment, furnishings and facilities, and the acquisition of lands or rights in lands in connection therewith, including underwriting discount and other costs of issuance of such bonds, in accordance with and ratifying and approving the provisions of Ordinance 2024-17 of the North Slope Borough adopted by the Borough Assembly on August 6, 2024, including the provisions thereof pertaining to reappropriations of the proceeds of any bonds to other Capital Projects and other Capital Project Funds under certain circumstances.</p> <p>YES -498 NO-154</p>
G.	<p>Proposition 7, Shall the North Slope Borough, Alaska, issue its general obligation bonds, in an amount not to exceed the sum of One Million Two Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$1,230,000) for the purpose of financing the cost, in whole or in part, of the construction, additions, improvements, betterments, repair, reconstruction or acquisition of communication facilities and facilities related thereto in the North Slope Borough as set forth in the Capital Budget Ordinance, together with all necessary appurtenances, equipment, furnishings and facilities, and the acquisition of lands or rights in lands in connection therewith, including underwriting discount and other costs of issuance of such bonds in accordance with and ratifying and approving the provisions of Ordinance 2024-18 of the North Slope Borough adopted by the Borough Assembly on August 6, 2024, including the provisions thereof pertaining to reappropriations of the proceeds of any bonds to other Capital Projects and other Capital Project Funds under certain circumstances.</p> <p>YES-523 NO-128</p>
H.	<p>Proposition 8, Shall the North Slope Borough, Alaska, issue its general obligation bonds, in an amount not to exceed the sum of Ten Million Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$10,550,000) for the purpose of financing the cost, in whole or in part, of the construction, additions, improvements, betterments, repair, reconstruction or acquisition of general capital projects and facilities related thereto in the North Slope Borough as set forth in the Capital Budget Ordinance, together with all necessary appurtenances, equipment, furnishings and facilities, and the acquisition of lands or rights in lands in connection therewith, including underwriting discount and other costs of issuance of such bonds, in accordance with and ratifying and approving the provisions of Ordinance 2024-19 of the North Slope Borough adopted by the Borough Assembly on August 6, 2024, including the provisions thereof pertaining to reappropriations of the proceeds of any bonds to other Capital Projects and other Capital Project Funds under certain circumstances.</p> <p>YES-551 NO -104</p>
