1.	The purpose of this Agreement is to set out the responsibilities of the parties hereto regarding the professional services to be rendered by contractor to District. District agrees to engage Contractor, and Contractor agrees to perform and/or provide the following services:  Amended contract for the provision of required orientation and mobility services for eligible visually impaired students in accordance with their individual education plan Invoice dated May 2013 exceeded contract agreement in the amount of \$1,207.21.
2.	Contractor will perform the services set forth herein in a timely and professional manner and to the District's satisfaction.
3.	In exchange for the Contractor's services, District will pay Contractor a fee of \$87.50 <b>per hour/per day/flat fee</b> [circle one]. The total fee is not to exceed \$51,207.21 . Any reimbursement for travel, meals, and lodging or other expenses will be in accordance with District policies and must be accompanied by appropriate receipts. Contractors will not be paid in advance of performing or providing the services. Invoices must be addressed to the Accounts Payable Dept. at the above address. Notwithstanding payment by the District pursuant to an approved invoice, the District reserves the right to audit said Agreement and the services rendered hereunder and to adjust said sum if incorrect or improper. Contractor agrees to refund to District any sums improperly or incorrectly paid Contractor upon notice of same by District. Payment on a properly submitted invoice will be made in accordance with the District disbursement payment schedule.
