Read Across America Week

During Read Across America Week, the Elementary School invited two authors to visit students and discuss their writing inspirations and drawing styles. Students in grades 4K-1 met with Thomas Meadows, a Frederic alumni, and heard him read his first published book, *The Tales of Tommy Tucker: The Thought that Out Thunk the Thinker!* Students in Grades 1-5 were able to meet with Tom Watson, author of Stick Dog, in the elementary library for his presentation. Both author/illustrators worked with the students to illustrate their favorite characters and scenes! Tom Watson also signed several brand new copies of Stick Dog for students to win. Ten students went home with a signed copy of book 1 and two lucky students' names were drawn for a bundle Stick Dog books 1-8 signed by Tom Watson himself!

There was also an independent reading challenge given to the students. They had to complete 300 minutes within 12 days. We had 40 students complete the challenge and get the shamrock charm. They also got to dress up as animals, athletes, heroes, fantasy characters, and in comfy pj's. In classrooms, there was an emphasis on read aloud and independent reading time. One of the highlights was the flashlight Friday reading time.
