Re: Police Officer Compensation

Question:

Trustee Stacey Donald Inquired Whether the College's Police Officer Starting Pay is Competitive

Answer:

Collin College currently has 25 police officers. Effective September 1, 2019, the police officers' salary range has a **base pay of \$48,668 and a range maximum of \$73,002.**

The actual 2019-2020 annual salaries of Collin's police officers range from \$49,948 to \$68,490 based on length of service at Collin College and up to ten (10) years of experience prior to coming to Collin College. The average annual base salary is \$60,289. The average length of service for current Collin College police officers is 5.5 years.

Peer Community Colleges and Area University Police Compensation:

The average starting salary for the large community colleges and area 4-year institutions is **\$44,146**. This includes a geographic adjustment to account for differences in the cost of living between various markets.

Local Police Department Compensation:

The average starting salary for police officers in area municipal police departments is **\$65,286.**

External Surveys:

The college also accessed comparative salary survey data. This data is based on median salary rather than base salary, as shown below. The external survey data of median salaries averages \$62,388 compared to Collin's median salary of \$58,780 and average base salary of \$60,289. By adding the 3% matching benefit, the average salary can come up to as much as \$62,098.

Recommendation:

Collin's starting base salary of \$48,668 for this position is higher than any of the large community colleges and is also above the average starting salaries of both peer institutions and the area's 4-year institutions.

Considering all comparable data, including peers, universities, and local municipal police salaries, the average market starting salary rate is **\$49,292**, which is generally comparable to Collin College's base salary with a difference of \$625 or 1.28%. Considering this overall perspective, **Collin College's police officers are appropriately placed in the staff compensation structure.**

We will continue to monitor the market and study the effectiveness of the college's **new Police Cadet** program. In the event the pool of qualified applicants for outstanding police officers slows and we see a need to adjust the base salary to a more competitive position within the local market—particularly with area municipal police departments with whom we compete for job applicants—we will consider an appropriate reclassification of the police officer position.
