The training 13 materials will be approved by the Office of Public Instruction (OPI). The District will provide at least two 14 (2) hours of youth suicide and prevention training beginning the 2017-2018 school year. The District will provide, at a minimum, two (2) hours of youth suicide awareness and prevention training every five (5) 15 16 years thereafter. All new employees who work directly with any student enrolled in the school district will be provided training the first year of employment. 17 18 19 Youth suicide and prevention training may include: 20 21 a. In-person attendance at a live training; 22 b. Videoconference; 23 c. An individual program of study of designated materials; 24 d. Self-review modules available online; and 25 e. Any other method chosen by the local school board that is consistent with professional 26 f. development standards. 27 28 No cause of action may be brought for any loss or damage caused by any act or admission resulting from 29 the implementation of the provisions of this policy or resulting from any training, or lack of training, 30 related to this policy.
