6. School Goals based on data analysis from Title 1 School Wide Plan: (Title 1 plan review of goals)
 - a. Goal 1 (Reading) - By June 2025 80% of K-2 will be benchmark in Correct Letter Sounds (DIBELS) and 80% of 3-5 students will be benchmark based on Oral Reading Fluency accuracy (DIBELS).
 - b. Goal 2 (Math) - By June 2025 the percentage of 4th-5th who meet the expectation of OSAS will increase by 10% that scored a level 2 in the year before to a level 3; 75% of 2nd-3rd grade students will be at or above benchmark

based on Acadience Math Concepts and Applications score; 75% of 1st grade students will score at or above benchmark for Acadience Math Computation score; and 80% of kindergarten students will be at or above benchmark for Acadience BQD (Beginning Quantity Discrimination) score.

- c. Goal 3 (Social Emotional) - During the 2025 school year, teachers will provide two monthly school wide character trait lessons focusing on the 5 key competencies of Social and Emotional Learning as noted in Madrona PBIS Leadership Committee meeting notes.
