KG-2nd Grade:

- Morrow County has been using SRA's Reading Mastery materials and McGraw Hill basal since 2000 as our primary delivery of reading instruction for elementary students. This combination of research-based direct instruction approach coupled with the basal has proven successful for all students, especially those lacking language development skills(ELL, poverty, etc). The K-2 language arts adoption committee have chosen to continue with this successful program for the upcoming adoption.
 - SRA Reading Mastery Plus (KG/1st Grade Level) with McGraw Hill basal.
 - ACH and SBE will upgrade from the Rainbow Edition of SRA to the Plus Edition that Heppner has been implementing for two years now with success.
 - SRA Reading Mastery Classic (1st/2nd Grade Level) with McGraw Hill basal.
 - ACH and SBE will update their materials from the Rainbow Edition of SRA to the Classic Edition for 1st/2nd Grades Levels.

3rd-6th Grade:

 Morrow County has been using McGraw Hill and SRA Reading Mastery as our primary focus towards upper elementary reading instruction. After thorough evaluation, it is the committee's recommendation to adopt the Scott Foresman Reading Street Curriculum coupled with SRA Reading Mastery Classic.

7th-12th Grades:

 Morrow County has been using the Glencoe basal for 7th-12th grade instruction. It is the unanimous recommendation of the committee that Morrow County adopt the Collegeboard's Springboard Curriculum coupled with the Glencoe basal for the upcoming adoption.
