Distinguished Achievement Program (DAP)

The Distinguished Achievement Program (DAP) is the highest graduation plan offered by the State of Texas. Students must complete the Recommended High School Program, third level of a foreign language, and four advanced measures.

Advanced measures include:

- 1. original research project qualified by a panel of judges
- 2. score of 3 or better on an Advanced Placement exam
- 3. PSAT Scholar/National Merit Scholar
- 4. a professional license through a licensing board (CATE)
- 5. successful completion of a dual enrollment course with a grade of B or better (in an academic area)

Texas Scholar

Texas Scholar is a program that encourages students to follow a more rigorous course load in high school.

Texas Scholar requires two of the following:

- 1. independent research project with presentation
- 2. portfolio with presentation
- 3. score of 3 or better on an Advanced Placement exam,
- 4. a professional license through a licensing board (CATE class).
- 5. successful completion of Dual Enrollment Class course with a grade of B or better (in an academic area)
