### Player's Jobs

- Be safe
- Mix up teams to make them fair. A staff member or student may help.
- Include all kids in the play. Pass to everyone.
- Kids that do not want to play stay off the field and do not disturb the game.
- No messing around
- Commit to play for the whole recess- no quitting
- Follow the rules in the shed
- Use belts with flags
- No unnecessary roughness- No tackling, shoving
- Be a good sport, no bragging, and play fair.
- Don't take it too seriously. It's not the Superbowl or NFL
- No name-calling
- If you are not following expectations
  1. Warning
  2. You are out of the game for the remainder of the recess.
  3. You will lose your football license.

### Flag Football Rules- 9-12players/ team

1. 4 downs- Don't run every time. Need a mix of passes, runs, and handoffs
2. Quarterback can run 1 time
3. Change positions and take turns
4. Use flags, no contact
5. Team needs to be onside and ready before you start the play.
6. Defense needs to count to 7 apples.
7. Once 4 downs are up, the ball stays at that mark and the other team gets the ball.

The field should be longer than it is wider with cones used to determine the centerline.

There will be no kickoff. Play will start on the hash mark near the offensive team's goal line. Rock Paper Scissors determines who gets first possession of the ball.

Scoring: Touchdown = 7 points

**GRANT OVERVIEW**

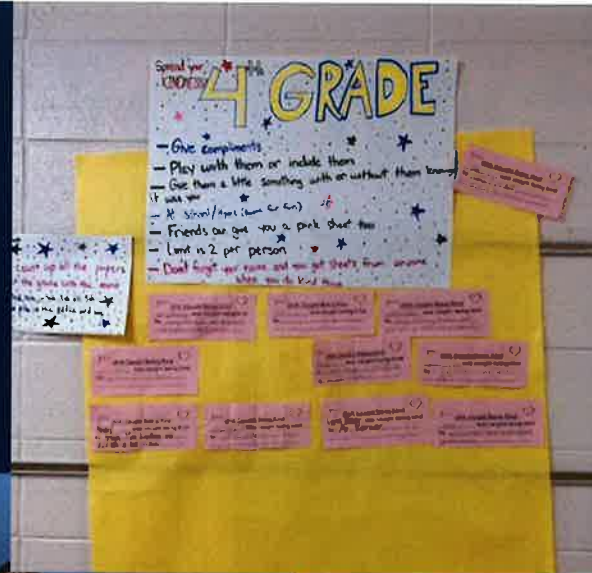

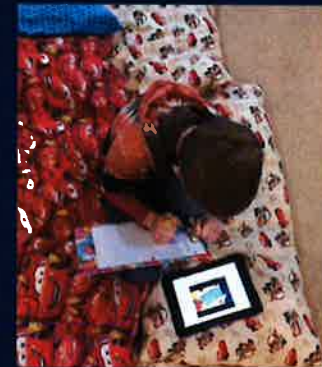
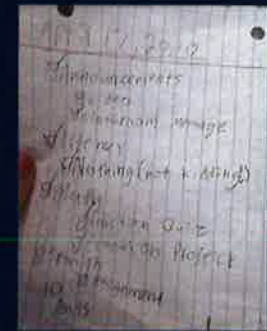
