## January 2024

### Tech Expansion

Phase 1 is progressing nicely. We began installing the base pads for the Warehouse and Powerline buildings. The drainage improvement between the Daycare and the new warehouse is coming along. The State approved vendor for the metal building will be onsite January 15-19 to assess the site and coordinate with our architect and engineer on design.

We also continue to assess the best alternative for site location of Phase 2 (Eagle Pass Automotive/HVAC expansion). Current plans call for utilization of the 18-acre property to ease congestion on the Chittim Campus.

### Academics

The college kicked off the Spring semester with Faculty Convocation on Tuesday, January 9<sup>th</sup>. Additional trainings were held the rest of the week. Dorm move-in begins this week and the first day of classes is Tuesday, January 16<sup>th</sup>.

### Other

On Tuesday, January 9<sup>th</sup> we hosted a meeting with the Middle Rio Grande Workforce Board, Texas Workforce Commission and College administration. We discussed ways to capitalize State Grants to expand training opportunities for the employers in our 11-county service area. I will also be attending the Texas Economic Development Council Winter Conference in San Antonio on February 21<sup>st</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup>.
