Lunch will be provided for volunteers, businesses, and presenters.

This quote includes the necessary equipment (Drapes, Tables, Chairs, and tablecloths) to provide 36 Job Fair/Career Fair booths. The remaining tables and chairs will be used to set up for lunch in the auxiliary gym for vendors.
