Claims

- For the month of February we will receive **\$183,148.72** in reimbursements from the USDA for lunch & breakfast. We received **\$162,367.06** last year and there was one extra day this year.
- The number of meals served this year for lunch was **50,220** compared to **47,298** last year for a difference of **2,922** more this year.
- The number of meals served for breakfast this year was **42,470** compared to **35,021** last year for a difference of 10,371 more this year. We fed **4,233** more this year at Heyburn because of breakfast in the classroom. We still show an increase of **6,138** for the rest of the schools for breakfast.

PROJECTS

- We are in the planning stages for a remodel at Minico so that we can replace the cooler and freezer boxes with larger ones.
- We will also be replacing four ovens this summer at Minico, West, East and Rupert Elementary.
