CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

The Curriculum Committee's charge is to perform orderly and ongoing review of existing curriculum per Board Policy and to make recommendations to the Board to ensure consistency with the District Mission, Vision, and best practices regarding curriculum review, adoption, and implementation, and evaluation.

The Committee works with the District Administration to review matters related to existing or new curriculum and educational programs, including but not limited to the review of graduation requirements, proposals concerning student courses, the Board's familiarity with district educational programs, the monitoring of student achievement, and the review of technology resources that support instruction. The Committee makes curriculum recommendations to the full School Board for consideration.

The Committee also reviews curriculum as established by Alaska Administrative Code (6-year review cycle). The review cycle below was initially approved by the School Board in May 2014 (Year 0).

Year 1 – Mathematics

Year 2 – English and Language Arts

Year 3 – Science

Year 4 – Social Studies, Music, Career Explorations

Year 5 – English Language Learners, Health, PE, Skills for a Healthy Living

Year 6 – Career and Technical Education

The Committee membership will consist of no more than two (2) Board Members, the Superintendent, member(s) of the District staff, and no fewer than one (1) representative of the community, as determined by the Superintendent. A student representative to the committee may be appointed, as desired.

Committee meetings are subject to the state open meetings act.
