PACE Outreach

The PACE offices are in full transition. The Anchorage office is moving to a smaller, safer location about three miles from the current office. Teachers will rotate through the office so it is fully staffed, and the change will result in substantial savings each month on rents. The Craig office moved to Craig High School for the FY 25/26 school year during construction. The Ketchikan office will close permanently at the end of the month. In addition to meeting the family needs, the PACE staff is focusing on the moves.
