To whom it may concern,

I am writing to request for an overnight stay at the Jackhammer Wrestling Tournament, which will take place in Pequot Lakes, MN, on December 19th and 20th, 2025.

The Jackhammer tournament is a two-day event, and Pequot Lakes is about four and a half four drive from Pipestone. I scheduled this tournament for the upcoming wrestling season because it offers a high level of competition that will benefit our wrestlers' development throughout the season and better prepare them for the postseason.

On Friday, December 19th, we plan to depart from the athletic doors of the school at 6:00 a.m. The wrestling team would plan to take the activity bus and one school vehicle to the tournament.
