Re: School Bus Stop-Arm Camera Interlocal Agreement

On April 28, 2014, the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approved a School Bus Stop-Arm Camera Interlocal Agreement Resolution giving me the authority to move forward with the development of an Interlocal Agreement with Dallas County Schools. The Interlocal Agreement has been drafted and negotiated by our attorneys at Walsh, Anderson.

As a reminder, in order for Dallas County Schools and the City of Coppell to be able to enforce the law that requires all vehicles to stop when the school bus stop-arm is displayed (and subsequently issue fines), Interlocal Agreements must be jointly adopted by Dallas County Schools, the City of Coppell, and Coppell ISD. Coppell ISD will receive 12.5% of the fines collected. There are no ongoing administrative duties required of us once this process is in place. Dallas County Schools is responsible for all administrative processes and fines.

Sergeant Casey Williams of the Coppell police and I will be present at the September 22nd Board meeting to explain the program, process, timeline, and to answer questions.

Recommendation:

That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve the Interlocal Agreement to Operate Stop Arm Camera Program between Dallas County Schools and Coppell Independent School District at the September 22, 2014 Board meeting.
