Paychecks are direct deposit on a semi-monthly pay schedule posted by the district every 15<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of the month. Questions regarding direct deposit should be directed to the Business Office at (361) 767-6600 ext. 2023.

Substitute positions requiring more than (4) hours of duty will be compensated for a full day. Any position requiring (4) hours or less will be compensated at the half-day rate. Half day assignments are paid at half of your daily rate. It is permissible to work two half days in different campuses if the working times coordinate.

The number of working days for each substitute is reported to the Payroll Department by each campus. It is very important to sign-in and sign-out at the campus where services are rendered.
